



Assembly pin for steering spindle (Fig. 5)	self-made

Removal

1 Disconnect cable on battery.




- Fig. 1 1 Steering 13 Hexagon socket screw 12 Steering coupling

2 Unscrew upper hexagon socket screw (13) from steering coupling (12) (Fig. 1).

- **3** Remove combination instrument (54.1.310):

4 Remove steering lock (46.1–640).

5 Loosen plug connection for cable assembly of jacket tube.

6 Unscrew hex bolts holding cover plate (7) to front end (Fig. 2).




Fig. 3 Cross member

7 Unscrew both locking screws (2) for attaching jacket tube to cross member (1) (Fig. 3).

8 Remove jacket tube.

Installation


If the jacket tube has been crushed by an accident, be sure to replace, since it can no longer be returned to its specified position.

9 Loosen clamping screw on fastening clip (6) (Fig. 2 and 6).







Fig. 4 5 Jacket tube

10 Locate steering spindle with assembly pin (25) through bore in jacket tube (5) (Fig. 4).

Note: Be sure to locate steering spindle, since it should not be axially displaced when installing jacket tube.

The assembly pin is self-made according to the dimensions shown in Fig. 5.



11 Check whether rubber sleeve (8) for sealing the steering spindle (2) is correctly located in jacket tube (5) (Fig. 6).

12 Insert jacket tube (5) into front end and cross member, making sure that the sealing shim (9) is correctly seated on cover plate (7) and is inserted into steering coupling (12) together with the steering spindle (2) (Fig. 6).

25 Assembly pin

13 Screw jacket tube (5) with both locking screws(2) to cross member (1), but do not yet tighten screws.(Fig. 7).



14 Attach cover plate to front end, then tighten locking screws on cross member and clamping screw on fastening clip.

15 Connect plug connection of cable assembly to each other.

16 Install steering lock.

17 Install instrument cluster (combination instrument).

18 Install steering wheel.

19 Screw upper clamping screw into steering coupling and tighten. Tightening torque 2.5 kpm (reference value).
