


Removing slide rails (89 and 89a)


1 Remove cylinder head cover. For this purpose, on (AUS), (J), (S) and (USA) starting 1977, push out clamp assembly of fuel hoses on holder and pull down fuel hoses with clamp assembly in forward direction over cylinder head cover.



2 On model 123, remove radiator if required for reasons of space.



- 3 On (USA) 1973-1975, remove vacuum pump.
- 4 Knock out slide rail bearing bolt with impact puller.
- 5 Remove slide rail in upward direction.




Installation

- 6 Coat bearing bolt on collar with sealing compound.
- 7 Position slide rail and knock-in bearing bolt with impact puller.


For this purpose, apply counterhold to slide rail with a screw driver.






Attention!

On plastic slide rails, the locating lug of slide rail must be seated in locating groove on lower or upper bearing bolt.



Since the plastic slide rail (89a) is also installed on other engines, the upper bearing bolt bore is designed as a double bore. When installing the upper bearing bolt, make sure that the bearing bolt is seated in the correct bore.

8 Mount cylinder head cover.




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
Removing slide rail (93)

- 1 Remove intermediate sprocket shaft (05-412).
- 2 On vehicles **model 123** with power steering, remove aluminum carrier of power steering pump (arrow).

Note: Not applicable on (aus), (J), (S) and (USA) starting 1977.



- 3 Knock-out bottom bearing bolt (91) with impact puller.
- 4 Unscrew upper bearing bolt (92).
- 5 Remove slide rail in upward direction through opening for intermediate sprocket.




Installation

- 6 Coat lower bearing bolt on collar with sealing compound.
- 7 Position slide rail and knock-in bottom bearing bolt with impact puller, while applying counterhold to slide rail by means of a screw driver.

Attention!


With plastic slide rail, the locating lug of the slide rail should be seated in locating groove on bottom bearing bolt.




8 Position upper bearing bolt and screw-in.

Note: Since the plastic slide rail is also installed on other engines, the upper bearing bolt bore is designed as a double bore. When inserting upper bearing bolt, make sure that the bearing bolt is seated in the correct bore.

- 9 For further installation proceed vice versa to the sequence of removal.
- 10 Check firing point (07.5-510).
