



## Removal

- 1 Uncotter castle nut of track rod and unscrew castle nut.
- 2 Force ball joint of track rod (10) from steering knuckle arm (23) by means of puller (064).



3 Unscrew both self-locking hex. screws (20) from steering knuckle and remove steering knuckle arm.



4 The steering knuckle arm cannot be checked with conventional shop equipment. If in doubt, particularly following an accident, install a new steering knuckle arm. Pay attention to correct code number (arrow) of steering knuckle arm.



## Installation

5 Clean contact surface for steering knuckle arm on steering knuckle (6).


Note: If a new steering knuckle arm is installed, make sure that the contact surfaces for the steering knuckle, the hex. head screws and the castle nuts are free of paint.




6 Fasten steering knuckle arm with two new self-locking hex. head screws (20) to steering knuckle. Tighten hex. head screws to specified torque of 80 Nm.

## Attention!

Self-locking hex. head screws must be renewed on principle.



- 7 Fasten track rod (10) to steering knuckle arm (23) by means of castle nut and cotter. Tightening torque 35 Nm reference value.
- 8 Check wheel adjustment on front axle (40-320).
