One-man hoist BE No. 15 543

- 1 Convert Celette adjusting bench according to chapter 60.1–200.
- 2 Remove motor, axles and tank.
- 3 Unscrew panel at front between front fenders.
- 4 Raise body (2) with two-column lifting platform or one-man hoist.

Note: Use one-man hoist only to lift bodies up to 750 kg in weight. Use 20 mm dia. holding pins with double plugs.

- **5** When letting down, make sure that the body is suspended horizontally.
- **6** During the straightening and welding jobs the body should be screwed to as many points on adjusting bench as possible. The following screw connections are available:
- 2 Domes for front axle carrier
- 12 Support for supporting bearing
- 16 Cross member for rear axle supports (60.1–200, Fig. 1).


