Oil level checkup	With the oil at operating temperature (approx. 80 °C) the oil level in supply tank should reach up to cast-in mark (approx. 20 mm below edge of tank). With the engine cold and at ambient temperature, oil level 6–8 mm below mark. For filling up, use perfectly clean oil only, since even the smallest particles of dirt may cause trouble in hydraulic system.
