

Removal


- 1 Remove instrument panel (68-100).
- 2 Remove center console (68-200).
- 3 Drain coolant.
- 4 Unscrew fastening screw (12) from holder (2) of distributing pipe and loosen hose straps of heating water feed hoses (refer to arrow).




5 Loosen hose strap from heating water return hose (refer to arrow).




6 Loosen screws and nuts from holders (1) and supporting angle (a).







- 7 Partially expose electrical harness in range of air conditioner cabinet (refer to arrows).
- 8 Unscrew screws on air ducts left and right for heating rear compartment.
- 9 Pull off air ducts on heater box.



- 10 Swivel air conditioner cabinet complete with connected refrigerant hoses approx. 20 cm to the rear.
- 11 Pull plug (b) from electric line for blower.




- 12 Disassemble coupler of electric line for resistor group (10).
- 13 Pull out resistor group (10) in upward direction.




Installation

- 14 Insert resistor group (10) and install electric line.
- 15 Complete coupler from electric line for resistor group and mount plug (b).




- 16 Move air conditioner cabinet into original position. Mount screws and nuts of holders (1) and supporting angle (a).
- 17 Plug on air ducts on heater box.
- 18 Mount fastening screws on air ducts left and right for heating rear compartment.



- 19 Attach exposed electrical harness.
- 20 Plug on heating water feed and return hoses and tighten hose straps.

21 Mount holder (2) of distributing pipe to front wall by means of fastening screw (12).



- 22 Install instrument panel (68-100).
- 23 Install center console (68–200).
- 24 Add coolant and bleed cooling system.
- 25 Check operation of automatic climate control.
