


13 On light alloy power steering pump 1st version, place steadying basket (60) into housing.



14 On light alloy power steering pump 1st version, press detent spring (58) on stud.







32b = ZF valve




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- 16 Clean volume control valve prior to assembly, immerse in manual transmission oil and introduce into housing bore. Valve should slide easily in housing bore.
- 17 Install pressure relief valve from respective repair set into volume control valve. Insert compression spring (50) first, then valve cone (51). Then place spacing washers (52) for adjusting opening pressure into valve screw (53).






- 18 Clamp volume control valve (32) with its unground part into vise, screw in valve screw (53) and tighten.
- 19 On grey iron power steering pump, insert compression spring (30) into bore of pump housing (2). Flush volume control valve once again, immerse in manual transmission oil and introduce into housing bore in such a manner that the valve screw is pointing inwards.
- 20 Fit a new O-ring (34) on closing plug (33). Force closing cover with bolt inwards into housing bore and secure by knocking in setpin.





21 On light alloy power steering pump, insert volume control valve (32) and compression spring (30) into housing.

Note: Install volume control valve in such a manner that valve screw of pressure relief valve is pointing toward closing plug.


Coat all parts with manual transmission oil prior to assembly.

1 Insert front circlip (55) into groove of drive shaft (11). Press on radial ball bearing and insert 2nd cir-


Note: Install all parts from splined end of drive shaft, to prevent damage to ground surface for radial sealing ring.

2 Press needle bearing into housing by means of assembly mandrel.











12 Insert O-ring (19), then pressure plate at cover end (3) into housing, making sure that blind hole of pressure plate slips over setpin.




13 Insert O-ring (21) into housing, place compression spring (5) on pressure plate.


Note: The O-rings (19) and (21) have different diameters. The O-ring with the small diameter seals the pressure plate, the larger O-ring the cover in realtion to housing.








19 If a new volume control valve is installed, make sure that the pressure relief valve has the correct opening pressure. Also pay attention to manufacturer of volume control valve.

32a = Vickers valve 32b = ZF valve



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
20 Install pressure relief valve into volume control valve. Insert compression spring (50) with pressure pin (54) first, then insert valve ball (51) on volume control valve 1st version. Place spacing washers (52) on valve screw (53) and screw valve screw into volume control valve.



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21 On 2nd version, insert compression spring (50), then valve cone (51). Then insert spacing washers (52) for adjusting opening pressure into valve screw (53).

Note: Always use the same washers which were previously installed.



- 22 Clamp volume control valve (32) with its unground part into vise and tighten valve screw.
- 23 Insert volume control valve and compression spring (32) into housing, screw in closing plug (59) with new sealing ring (34) and tighten.
